CATEGORY A

An ex-pupil of BSG, who is thinking about going into teaching, and wants to come back to the school to do some lesson observations.

that you contact another school in the local area, particularly if you only left the school in the last five years so that you can gain experience of a different kind of school.

CATEGORY B

Someone who is thinking about going into teaching, and wants to come to the school to do some lesson observations.

WE ASK YOU TO ...

email the professional mentor, sellsmore@bsg.bournemouth.sch.uk outlining which subject(s) you are interested in and the dates you are available.

CATEGORY C

Someone who has applied for and gained a place on a teacher training course, and wants to come to the school for a few days to fulfil a requirement of that course. Priority will be given to those applicants from HEIs that the school is already in partnership with: BPD SCITT, the University of Southampton and the Aspirations Teaching Alliance.

CATEGORY D

Someone who is already on a teacher training course, and wants to come to the school for a short placement.
