

School Measures of Performance 2017

GCSE

Our **Progress 8** score was **0.57** (confidence limits 0.37-0.78). This means that our pupils performed over half a grade better in the GCSE exams than similar pupils nationally.

Our **Attainment 8** score was **71.64** in 2017. This means that the average grade achieved by our pupils was around a grade A/grade 7.

Percentage of pupils who got a **strong pass in English and maths** (Grade 5 or above) **93%**

Percentage of pupils who got a **pass in English and maths** (Grade 4 or above) **100%**

Percentage of **pupils achieving the English Baccalaureate** combination of subjects. (This means pupils who got a GCSE grade C or above in English, maths, 2 sciences, a language, and history or geography) **61%**

NB we currently have no compulsion at GCSE to follow the EBacc programme, and whilst it remains a very strong recommendation, we believe it more important that pupils have relative freedom of choice of subjects relevant to their needs.
