

Information for Applicants for the post of Teacher of Geography and History/ Humanities

We are seeking to appoint in September 2017 a well-qualified, enthusiastic and energetic graduate who would relish the challenge of teaching pupils who are able and keen to learn.

This is a part-time post for one year in the first instance. You will be able to offer Geography, at least to GCSE and also lower school History/Religious Studies. Alternatively it could be combined with other subjects, the Head of House or Assistant Head of Sixth Form post to make a full-time permanent post. A contribution to the wider life of the school would also be an asset.

NQTs or more experienced teachers are encouraged to apply.

The Geography Department consists of 4 specialist teachers and teaching will be available across the 11-16 age range initially, with the possibility of A level work for a suitably qualified candidate.

The History Department consists of 5 specialist teachers and teaching will be available across the 11-16 age range.

The Religious Studies Department consists of 3 specialist teachers and teaching will be available across the 11-16 age range.

All departments are housed in a purpose built suite of classrooms equipped with DVD facilities and interactive whiteboards. Classes also have access to the extensive central IT facilities equipped with networked PCs with use of the internet and multimedia, as well as department based laptop computers.
